Subject: Bulletin Management

And now for something completely different - a bulletin about Bulletin Management

Over the years we have published well over 100 bulletins advising our Dealer/Distributor customers of product changes, phenomenon like whiting on the glass and when to use what sealants. We have published these bulletins using three different formats to assist in the management of this information.

- > Technical Bulletins (TB) are used to address information that is timeless (continues to be of use) and generally related to multiple products.
- ➤ Product Information Bulletins (PIB) are used to introduce a change or new product. These detailed bulletins are time sensitive and may lose their relevance as time passes and the products life cycle matures.
- ➤ Product Information News (PIN) are similar to Product Information Bulletins as they too introduce product changes but they tend to address changes that don't require as much explanation.

If you are filing hard copies of the bulletins in a binder then use an index sheet to identify the numerically filed bulletins. The index will enable you to quickly locate the bulletin you are seeking. Up to date index sheets are posted on the Dealer Website or you can request a copy from our Customer Service team.

Soft electronic copies are also available on the Dealer Website and are posted with descriptions to identify the subject content of each bulletin. You can set up a link or download a pdf of each bulletin for easy reference on your own PC.

So what is the best method of managing or filing these bulletins? As described, the Technical Bulletins are timeless and not product specific so whether you're filing them in a binder or in an electronic folder, they are best grouped together and listed numerically. PIB's and PINs can also be grouped together and filed numerically if you are using an index sheet to catalogue them but you might also find it useful to file these with other product specific information such as price sheets etc.

Subject: Sealing the Vent System on Napoleon Direct Vent Gas Fireplaces

Almost 15 years ago, we first published a bulletin regarding the application of the appropriate high temperature sealant to be used on direct vent fireplace venting connections. In spite of the fact those requirements are clearly defined in our installation instructions, we have recently received multiple reports where our direct vent gas fireplaces have been installed without applying the sealant appropriately. There are two different installation scenarios we would like to review so installers are better equipped to successfully install direct vent gas fireplaces.

First, the direct vent gas stoves. We have always used a 7" stove pipe as the combustion air conduit on these models and yes, all joints of these pipes must be sealed using high temperature sealant. Symptoms that indicate these joints aren't sealed include intermittent main burner and pilot outages and/or the outer 7" vent pipe becomes frosted up at the point closest to the exit through the wall. These symptoms can occur since the unsealed vent pipe joints allow the system to interact with the atmospheric pressures within the home and will also create an imbalance between the exiting glue gases and the incoming combustion air. Since the outer stove pipes are highly visible in an installation, we recommend first assembling and securing these pipes before applying the sealant on the exterior surface of the joint. The sealant can then be covered up using Decorative Brass or Metallic Black Bands (W025-0001 or W025-0003). This practice is acceptable on stove venting since the vent pipes are accessible to be inspected at anytime.

The second scenario concerns the sealing of the exhaust collar of the fireplace to the venting. The temperatures at this location so close to the firebox can be as high as 700° F. which is well beyond the 600° F tolerances of most high temperature sealants such as Red RTV Silicone. When Red RTV sealant is used in this location, it will quickly dry out, turn to dust, failing to maintain a seal between the exhaust flue and the combustion air surrounding it in the outer vent pipe. An incomplete seal in this area will permit the flue gases to contaminate the combustion air feeding the fire. The symptoms of this condition can include intermittent main burner and pilot outages along with dirty flames that generate soot and carbon. Millpac with a temperature tolerance of 1,000° F is the only high temperature sealant that can withstand the temperatures at the exhaust flue and therefore must be used in this location.

There are many important aspects to installing Direct Vent Gas Fireplaces and not the least of them is applying the proper sealant to all vent pipe joints or connections.

Flat Black Paint Changing to Metallic Black on Napoleon Wood burning Stoves and Inserts: After many years of painting these products flat black we are making a concerted change to what most consider to be a richer colour, Metallic Black. This change will be implemented simultaneously beginning in March production with these stoves, inserts and associated kits such as doors, blowers & trims. The only Napoleon wood burning stove or insert and related accessories that will remain flat black will be the EPA 1600. Watch for more details prior to our launching this new colour.

I3BK Blower Kit Thermal-disc Bracket Change: One of our diligent Customers pointed out to us that the thermal disc bracket in the IR3 Insert blower kit did not permit the thermal disc to make contact with the insert firebox. This oversight has been corrected and we thank that Customer for reporting this specific issue as well as the others who have reported similar conditions to us in the past.

Blower Kits Become Green: By now many of you have likely discovered the significant improvement of the packing material used in our blower kits. We now use a reconstituted cardboard material to protect the blowers from damages that can occur through the shipping and handling process.

Gas Power Ventor Now Compatible with Remote Controls: Soon to be released, the control module included in the Power Vent Adaptor kits will be changed to one designed to operate the power ventor and gas fireplace with a single pole switch instead of the double pole switch which includes hand held remotes.

EPA 1900 Secondary Air Manifold Now Removable: To improve the serviceability of this workhorse of a woodstove, the secondary air manifold has been redesigned so that it now removable. Subject to extremely high temperatures from the large fires it can be exposed to, this feature will make it simple to replace a damaged manifold. Look for this change in new EPA1900 models shipping soon.

EPA 1450 Woodstove Receives a Stainless Steel Baffle Shield: For increased durability a gasket and stainless steel baffle shield has been added to this stove. Watch for this change as current inventory changes over.

BIOMASS STOVE TAX CREDIT (USA)

\$300 Biomass Stove Tax Credit Reinstated for 2012 - 2013

A federal tax credit on 75 percent efficient biomass heating appliances, which expired on December 31, 2011, was reinstated by the "fiscal cliff" legislation, the American Taxpayer Relief Act of 2012 (H.R. 8), signed by President Obama on January 2, 2013. The bill includes a "tax extender" for Internal Revenue Service Section 25C which provides a tax credit for, among many other things, qualifying biomass burning stoves. The extender provides a 10 percent tax credit of up to \$300 on a qualifying biomass heating appliance purchased between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2013. Lifetime Limitation – The tax code is famous for its "lifetime limitation" language and this tax credit is no different. As with historical tax credits available to the industry, rather than attempting to explain the complicated details of lifetime limitations. HPBA prefers to say, "PLEASE CONSULT YOUR TAX ADVISOR FOR DETAILS OF HOW THIS WILL AFFECT YOU" in all of our comments, both written and oral, about this credit.

What is the Biomass-Burning Stove Tax Credit?

This federal tax credit encourages people to make energy-conscious purchases that improve the energy efficiency of their home. It is an up to \$300 credit you can get for buying a qualifying biomass-burning stove or fireplace insert between January 1, 2012 and December 31, 2013. Biomass simply means the stove uses wood or pellet fuel.

Consumers claim the credit on their federal income tax form at the end of the year. This new credit reduces the amount of tax you owe. This tax credit is a non-refundable tax credit available for individuals who pay taxes and who make energy-conscious purchases to improve the energy efficiency of their home.

Note: With regard to tax credits vs. tax deductions, in general, a tax credit is more valuable than a similar tax deduction. A tax credit reduces the tax you pay, dollar-for-dollar. Tax deductions - such as those for home mortgages and charitable giving - lower your taxable income.


